Series- The greatest letter ever written? Prt 5.

Death through Adam, life in Christ

“8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

(Romans 5:8)

**1. God in his grace has brought us peace with God.
(Rom 5:1-11).**

**2. Death through Adam and life through Christ.
(Rom 5:12-21).**

A. Examining the texts.

1. Read Romans 5:1-5. What do these verses reveal about what God has done for us in Christ?
2. Read Romans 5:6-11. What does this section tell us about the nature of God? What has he done for us?
3. Read Romans 5:12-17. What does this section say about human nature and its state? Why is the gift not like the trespass?
4. Read Romans 5:18-21. What according to this- "does the obedience of the one man" make?

B. Meditation & application

5. The word "we" is used a multitude of times in the opening section of this section. Given Paul's discussion about Jews and Gentiles being one people of God why is the "word we," significant?
6. What does Paul say has been done for us in these verses? List the benefits of salvation and think in light of David's statement in the Psalms- "restore unto me the joy of my salvation."
7. This passage is prolonged meditation on the wonder of our salvation. How does this chapter add to your picture of the awe and wonder of being saved? Spend time in worship of Christ- and thanking God for what he has done?
