The Lord has spoken!

1 The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. 2 Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. Psalm 19:1-2

1. The heavens declare the glory of God. Psalm 19:1-6.

2. The law of God is perfection. Psalm 19:7-11.

3. Oh God- Make me whole. Psalm 19:12-14.

A. Examining the texts.

1. Psalm 19:1-6. How does the Psalmist see the heavens? What is their voiceless message?
2. Read Psalm 19:7-11. What delights the Psalm writer about the law of God? What does he see in it and what purpose does it play for him?
3. Read Psalm 19:12-14. What do you think the Psalmist is saying in this section of the Psalm and why has he got to this point?

B. Meditation & application

1. When you look at “the heavens,” do you think about God? If so- what does it make you think about him?
2. Some have suggested that this Psalm is two Psalms put together. A creation Psalm and a Torah Psalm. But I think there is a unity. Can you see a way or ways that this Psalm is a unity?
3. What would you say that this Psalm teaches us about both God and about us?
4. How can you use this Psalm be utilized in prayer and worship?
