Sermon Based Questions

Series- King is the Kingdom prt 3

What Kind of King will Jesus be?

12 Jesus answered, "It is said: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.' 13 When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time.

Luke 4:1-12

1. Jesus is a faithful King who remains faithful under fire

THE TEMPTATIONS

A. If you are the Son of God tell this stone to become bread.

B. If you worship me it will be yours.

C. If you are the Son of God, he said, throw yourself down from here.

A. Examining the texts.

1. Read Luke 4:1-4. This first temptation has within it. What are they? How does Jesus respond to this temptation and what scripture does he utilize?
2. Read Luke 4:5-8. What was the second temptation? How does Jesus respond and what scripture does he use?
3. Read Luke 4:9-13. What temptation is Jesus confronted with here? What scripture does he cite and how does he use it?
4. Jesus was faithful in the wilderness. How does this contrast with Israel and her behavior in the wilderness? What does this say about Jesus and his faithfulness?

B. Meditation & application

5. How does this passage and Jesus encounter with Satan reveal about his identity and the kind of Messiah might be?
6. Jesus used scripture to refute the devil- how does his example speak to us about dealing with temptation? How can the believer “arm themselves,” against temptation and sin through the Word? What role if any does scripture memory play here? How could you grow in this regard?
7. Think of one area in which you have an ongoing struggle with sin in. Find an appropriate scripture that speaks into that struggle and memorize it. Pray for Gods help in renewing your mind and helping you to be faithful in the face of sin?

A Prayer: Heavenly Father- We thankyou that your Son was faithful under fire and refused to give in to the devil and his temptations. Help us to put faith in Christ who triumphed over the enemy. Help us to love, memorize and meditate on your word and renew our minds in Jesus Name. Amen.
