(Isaiah 52:7-10)

Peace for a Change!

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"- Isaiah 52:7

- 1. Peace is coming!**
- 2. Peace is about who is in charge.**
- 3. God takes charge and a new King arrives!**
- 4. Jesus brings peace to those who make him king both now and in the future.**
- 5. The King's children are called to announce peace to others.**

A. Examining the Text

1. Read Isaiah 52:7. What does this verse say about the good news?
2. Read Isaiah 52:8. What are the watchmen in this verse joyous about?
3. Read Isaiah 52:9. What was the good news for the ruin of Jerusalem?
4. Read Isaiah 52:10. How would the Lords' holy arm work itself out?
5. Read Romans 10:8-16. How does this passage utilize Isaiah 52:7 and how does it paint the picture of the salvation that it alluded to?

B. Meditation & application

6. What is the good news alluded to by Isaiah 52 and what makes it good?
7. How is Jesus the fulfillment of Isaiah 52:7-10 and Gods' saving work?
8. How does Paul in Romans 10 illuminate the mission of God in the world and how is it encouragement to us as the church?
9. What is one habit you could implement in your life to be faithful to the call to be a person that has "beautiful feet?"
10. Who could you pray for this week everyday to come to experience salvation?
