Reading: Hebrews 4:15-5:14

The Great High Priest

15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. 16 Let us then approach God’s throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:15-16

1. Jesus the Great high Priest Hebrews 4:15-5:10

2. By this time- you ought to be teachers. Hebrews 5:11-15

A. Examining the texts.

1. Read Hebrews 4:14-16. What does this section reveal to us about the high priestly ministry of Jesus and what are the implications of this ministry according to verse 16 for the Hebrews?
2. Read Hebrews 5:1-4. What observations are made here about the nature of the Old Testament nature of the high priestly ministry based in Leviticus?
3. Read Hebrews 5:5-10. In what ways does Jesus high priestly ministry mirror that of the Old Testament ministry of the high priest?
4. Read Hebrews 5:11-14. What does this section reveal to us about the nature of the community to which the author was writing?

B. Meditation & application

5. From this passage, how does Jesus help us in our daily struggle to be obedient to God?
6. What difference does the fact that Jesus is seen as a great high priest make to you in your Christian discipleship?
7. How according to Heb 5:11-14, can one keep from being infantile in their faith?
8. How does this passage add to your picture of who Jesus is? Spend time in praising God for the gift of his Son.
