**Warning, Laziness & the Promises of God.**

*11 We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized. 12 We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.*

*Heb 6:11-12*

**1. Warning against falling away. Heb. 6:1-12**

**2. Gods promises can be trusted. Heb. 6:13-20.**

### **A. Examining the texts.**

1. Read Hebrews 6:1-3. Why does the author begin this chapter with the word, “therefore?” What is he referring too and what is his point in these 3 verses?
2. Read Hebrews 6:4-12. What is the author saying in verses 4-8? How does it serve his ultimate point?
3. Read Hebrews 6:13-20. What is the authors main point here? What is he saying about God here and how does this section serve his ultimate point?

### **B. Meditation & application**

4. What difference does the idea that God is good to his word make to the notion of Christian perseverance?
5. Are there any ways in which you feel as though you have been characterized by laziness in your Christian discipleship that this passage speaks into?
6. How could you encourage and warn someone who is struggling in their faith using this passage? What could you say to them to help them move beyond laziness toward maturity?
7. What do you make of the statement- “God does not lie,”in this passage and how could that statement shape your discipleship and trust of his word?

Prayer: Heavenly Father- when we think about how quick we are to become apathetic and how quickly we are moved to unbelief, help us to remember that your word is true and your promises are sure and help us to be zealous, not lazy, committed not passive. In Jesus Name- Amen
