Sermon Based Questions



Date- Sunday 17th March 2024 Series: Knowing & Following pt 6

Transfigured

2 After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. 3 His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. – Mark 9:2-3

1. Jesus is Gods beloved Son- Listen to him! Mark 9:1-8

2. After the resurrection- its time to let the secret out. Mark 9:9-13.

A. Examining the texts.

- 1. Read Mark 9:1-8. What do you think is meant by verse 1? What problems does it raise for us and how is it (if it is) connected to the next 7 verses?
- 2. Read Mark 9:1-4. What do you think is the significance of the appearance of Elijah and Moses?
- 3. Read Mark 9:5-8. What is the significance of the voice from the cloud? How significant do you think this moment is for Peter? (2 Peter 1:16-18)
- 4. Read Mark 9:9-13. As they came down the mountain- why do you think the disciples asked Jesus about Elijah? Who was the Elijah that was to come according to Jesus?
- 5. Read Mark 9:13. How is what happened to "the Elijah figure and what happened to Christ, synonymous?"

B. Meditation & application

- 6. How is the "transfiguration" a foretaste of the second coming?
- 7. What reasons does the transfiguration give for the disciples to: "Listen to Jesus?"
- 8. How does this passage imply that Jesus is the fulfilment of the whole story of God?
- 9. In what ways does this story mirror the story of Moses encounter with God in Exodus 24:15-18?
- 10. Based on Matthews portrayal of Joseph in what ways is he an example worthy of emulation for the believer in Christ?
