- 2. Read Acts 6:11 & 13. What are the two charges brought against Stephen?
- 3. Read Acts 7:2-43. What does Stephen say about Israels attitude towards Gods messengers in general and Moses in particular? What characteristics of God are highlighted in these verses?
- 4. Read Acts 7:44-50. How had Israel blasphemed God in their attitude to the temple? What did Solomon say about Gods presence and the temple?
- 5. Read Acts 7:51-53. Why did verses 51-53 anger the Sanhedrin so much?

B. Meditation & application

- 6. How are we guilty of brushing aside Gods messengers to us?
- 7. How do we determine who speaks the truth?
- 8. What does it look like for us to see God as a pilgrim God?
- 9. Do you think Gods messengers can expect to be safe passengers in this world?
- 10. How do we see God at work in this passage and how can that encourage us?
- 11. What can we learn from the courage and conviction of Stephen? How does this passage teach us about the cost of mission?
